FLOYDADA (Special) - Services for Glenn Jarnagin, 82, of Floydada will be at 2 p.m. Friday in First Christian Church with the Rev. Jim Woodworth, former interim pastor of First Christian Church, officiating. The Rev. Ione Sedinger, pastor, and the Rev. Michael Passmore, senior pastor of First Christian Church in Lubbock, will assist.

Burial will be in Floyd County Memorial Park under direction of Moore-Rose-White Funeral Home of Floydada.

Jarnagin died Tuesday, July 15, 1997, in Methodist Hospital in Lubbock.

He was born Oct. 1, 1914, in Killeen. He graduated from South Plains community schools. He married Evelyn Floriene Dorrell on May 17, 1942. She died in 1994. He was a 32nd degree mason, and he was a member of the Masonic Lodge 712 of Floydada. He was a member and elder of First Christian Church of Floydada. He was a U.S. Army Air Corps veteran of World War II.

He was a farmer and a mail carrier, and he retired from Della Plains schools, where he was a shop teacher. A son, Gary, died in 1996.

Survivors include a son, Joe Mack of Port Orchard, Wash.; a brother, Floyd of Midland; two sisters, Mamie Lou Hartman of South Plains and Anne Gayle Horn of Lubbock; five grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.
